Rev. Gabriel Asiamah Agyekum is an ordained Minister of the Ghana Baptist

Convention. He currently serves as the Senior Pastor of Redemption Baptist Church (RBC) Cape Coast. Prior to his

current role, Rev. Agyekum was the Associate Minister of Praise Baptist Church, Kakumdo, Cape Coast, for over a decade. With over eight years of experience as a Minister of the Gospel, including a significant role as an Associate Minister, Rev. Agyekum is dedicated to leading the church in spiritual growth, outreach, and community service in honour of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. He is the current chairperson of the Cape Coast Baptist Ministers Fellowship.

Rev. Agyekum also serves as an Assistant Lecturer at the Ghana Baptist University College, Adonai Campus in Cape Coast.
